1. Two colour photographs of Ian Smith, Prime Minister of Rhodesia taken in London, 1979. Acquired by David Saffery from Peter Yeates, former Secretary of the Bath Branch of the Anglo-Rhodesian Society.
2. Two black and white photographs of a meeting or meetings of the Bristol Branch of the Anglo-Rhodesian Society. The words 'MEETING BRISTOL BRANCH ANGLO-RHOD SOC 70'S' are written on the back of one of the photographs. Acquired by David Saffery from Peter Yeates, former Secretary of the Branch.

Acknowledges receipt of a letter dated 26<sup>th</sup> June enclosing 'the full text of General Sir Walter Walker's address to both the Yorkshire and Bristol/Bath Branches' of the Anglo-Rhodesian Society.

Bailey when the latter visited Bristol.
