4. MS. 602. Accounts, bills, and receipts, for the binding and purchase of books. 1901-13.

## Introduction

The accounts, bills, and receipts, are for the binding of books, and for books bought by Foxwell, with Goldsmiths' Company funds, to add to the Goldsmiths' Library. They (the accounts, etc.) were given to the University Library by the Goldsmiths' Company in 1963.

The booksellers' bills nearly always give some description of each item, often with an item number, when a book was ordered from a catalogue. Some items are marked by Foxwell 'not to Library' or bear other notes in his hand. Most of the bills are from booksellers in Great Britain, but there are a few from the U.S.A., France, and Germany.

Most of the binding was done by Stoakley & Son of Cambridge, although other binders, including Douglas Cockerell, were occasionally employed. The binders' bills give a short identification of each work, with a note on the style of binding.

Included with the accounts are a few letters and receipts, with statements of expenditure drawn up by the Goldsmiths' Company. The accounts were forwarded by Foxwell to the Goldsmiths' Company. Many of the covering letters are included in MS. 790, and were presumably separated from the accounts as they were received by the Goldsmiths' Company.
